\$5000 from town to ACC is split 50/50 between Marketing and Promotion

- JH wondered what we are supposed to be marketing.
- We're unsure of how in depth the TA or Select Board wants us to go, or what exactly they're anticipating.
- RC gets a sense that the town wants ACC to publicize the grant offerings more regularly and robustly, the
 problem is we don't often know the dates of the events, grantees mostly confirm dates later and do their own
 advertising.
- The ACC already shares announcements of Ashburnham and area cultural events on their Facebook page.
- The Mass Cultural Council stipulates that grant recipients are responsible for their own advertising of events.
- Where else do people get their info (other than FB, IG or Twitter)? Town website is bad and difficult to navigate.
- Remember, it takes someone to maintain any social media accounts.
- Ashburnham Community Journal (newsletter then became a website, no longer exists) was effective for advertising community events. We don't have any one source like that anymore.
- Large scale signs/sandwich boards who maintains?
- A centrally located, highly visible, outdoor information kiosk or bulletin board who maintains?
- Banner over Main St not easily changeable
- Flags on downton lamp posts saying what?
- Can a large-scale art installation fall under marketing or promotion?
- Can we do something like the dogs painted by students that Oakmont did in Westminster?
- A big event can be a reception for creatives to meet, which the ACC did years ago
